#### HOURS:

Published hours for the Flea Market are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. If you have prepaid and have confirmation of your spot you may go directly to your space and set up after <u>4 p.m. on Friday May. 24th.</u> If you have not pre-registered you can come to the Historical Society Office located on the east side of Main Street next to the Post Office to see what spaces are available. **Office Hours during the Flea Market are 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.** 

#### **SPACE INFORMATION:**

\$50 for one (22' long x 15' deep) regular vendor space/\$90 for one (22' long x 15' deep) food vendor space. You <u>MUST</u> stay within your boundary lines, which are clearly marked. On the Main Street <u>a 14' Emergency Traffic Lane will be</u> <u>strictly enforced</u>. You will be asked to move your booth if you are outside your designated area. Parking is not allowed in the Church parking lot.

#### **ELECTRICITY:**

\$25 for regular vendor/\$35 for a food vendor. Food vendors have priority since electricity is very limited. No air conditioning or heaters allowed as the system will not handle that load.

**REFUNDS:** Absolutely no refunds or rollovers after May 1, 2024.

**TAXES:** Payment of Nebraska Sales Tax is YOUR responsibility. By law all vendor information must be provided by the Organizer to the State of Nebraska.

<u>OTHER:</u> No food or beverages may be sold at the Fair without explicit permission from the fair organizer. All Food Vendors must have a valid Nebraska Food Permit. A copy of this permit must be provided to the Fair Organizer at each Fair. No alcoholic beverages are allowed.

We take pride in having a clean fair and work hard to keep it that way. We appreciate your help and cooperation. No draining of sewage is permitted on Flea Market or town premises. Garbage cans and dumpsters are provided throughout the fair. If you need a garbage bag, let us know. Public and portable restrooms are located throughout the Fair.
